“Dean Martin” Coming To LB2 for 100th Birthday

June 7, 2017 marks the 100th anniversary of the birth of Dean Martin, one of the most popular and enduring American entertainers of the mid-20th century.

In his one-man show "That's Amore: A Century Of Dean Martin" Dave DeLuca imitates Martin's relaxed, warbling

crooning voice as he performs signature songs such as You're Nobody till Somebody Loves You, Volare, Ain't That a Kick in the Head, and That's Amore.

Dean was nicknamed the King of Cool for his seemingly effortless charisma and self-assuredness, he and Jerry Lewis were partners in the

internationally acclaimed comedy team Martin and Lewis; and he was a member of Frank Sinatra's Rat Pack as well as a star in concert and in recordings, motion pictures, and television.
